


<p>1</p> <p>Create FSA ID and Password</p> 	<p>By September 15, 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create your FSA ID in June before September 15, 2020 www.fsaaid.ed.gov FSA ID takes 1-3 days to verify with social security administration to confirm your identity The 2020/2021 FAFSA is available for filing on or after 10/1/2020) Create or activate your Xello account at https://xello.world/en/middle-and-high-school/ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The FSA ID is your legal signature online and the name needs to match the name on your social security card Both student and one parent will need the verified FSA ID to sign and submit the FAFSA online. <p>2</p> <p>Apply for FAFSA</p> <p>Create California Colleges account and link to the FAFSA (New at FUSD)</p>	<p>FAFSA opens 10/01/2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> State deadline 3/2/2021 Federal deadline 6/30/2021 <p>Note: ALL FUSD students must create the California Colleges account and link to the FAFSA from California College site.</p> <p>Note: Students in foster care will need to also complete a Chafee Application for a Chafee grant www.chafee.csac.ca.gov</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The financial aid covers educational expenses for college several types of financial aid, including grants, scholarships, work study and loans are available to eligible applicants Start applying for scholarships early. <p>2</p> <p>Apply for DREAM ACT</p>	<p>DREAM ACT opens 10/1/2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deadline 3/02/2021 Dreamers must complete an affidavit at their school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Helps undocumented students who met AB 540 and AB68 pay for college Only state aid available to cover educational expenses 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> https://dream.csac.ca.gov/ www.csac.ca.gov Many Colleges have a Dream Centers http://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov
<p>3</p> <p>What to Expect after applying to FAFSA/DREAM ACT – email notification from federal student aid or CSAC</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st EMAIL: immediately sent after submission, ONLY CONFIRMS APPLICATION SUBMISSION <u>this is not a confirmation of being processed.</u> 2nd email: INDICATES EITHER “Processed Successfully” or “Action Required” 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If “Action required” student will need to go back into the FAFSA using their verified FSA ID to make corrections and re-verify with social security administration. If “Processed Successfully” you will then go to next step MAKE SURE TO READ ALL OF YOUR E-MAILS 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Power point Financial Aid T.V. answers your question 24/7 https://fresnocitycollege.financialaidtv.com/ www.tuitionfundingsources.com
<p>4</p> <p>Review your Student Aid Report (SAR)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You’ll receive the SAR depending on when you submitted the FAFSA If you provided an email address when you submitted the FAFSA, you can expect to receive your SAR within 1-5 days after submitting electronically 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your SAR is a summary of the FAFSA data you submitted Review your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number.
