



Bullard High School 8th Grade Registration

Frequently Asked Questions:

Is this presentation on Feb. 22nd only for students going to Bullard next year?

- No, students who are pre registered at another school within Fresno Unified should also attend. The high school content is the same across the district and the electives at the school that you are pre registered for will be visible to you when you complete the elective ranking tool

What if I am going to go to another school outside of FUSD?

- Sometimes plans change and it will not hurt to pre-register at Bullard in case your transfer is not granted or something changes between now and August.

What if I want to go to Bullard High but it is showing another school or no school on my student portal?

- It is likely that you need to submit a transfer request to our FUSD Transfers office because your address in ATLAS is showing as outside of the Bullard boundaries. If you have already submitted a transfer you should receive a letter when a decision is made, usually in April. If your transfer is granted, contact Bullard High Registration at 451-4320 or email Melinda.Roberts@fresnounified.org, Asst. Registrar to get information about registering at Bullard High.

How will I know what other courses I get?

- You will receive an email in late April/Early May with all your courses listed. Take a few minutes to double check all your courses and follow the directions and deadlines in the email to request a change if you do not like a course or want to take something else. If everything looks great and you are happy, Bullard High will send out information over the summer on where to locate you schedule in August.
