Steps to Matriculate to Community College

September-November: Complete online application through CCCApply

October-March: Complete FAFSA/CADAA Financial Aid Application to qualify for free tuition

December: Complete Online Orientation

March: Attend and Complete Mandatory Advising

April: Register for classes using your Student Educational Plan (SEP) created during Advising

Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSP&S)

What is DSPS?

- Program that provides accommodations and support to students who have a verified disability
- High School IEP's and 504's do not automatically transfer to college
- Students must apply for and request accommodations through DSPS

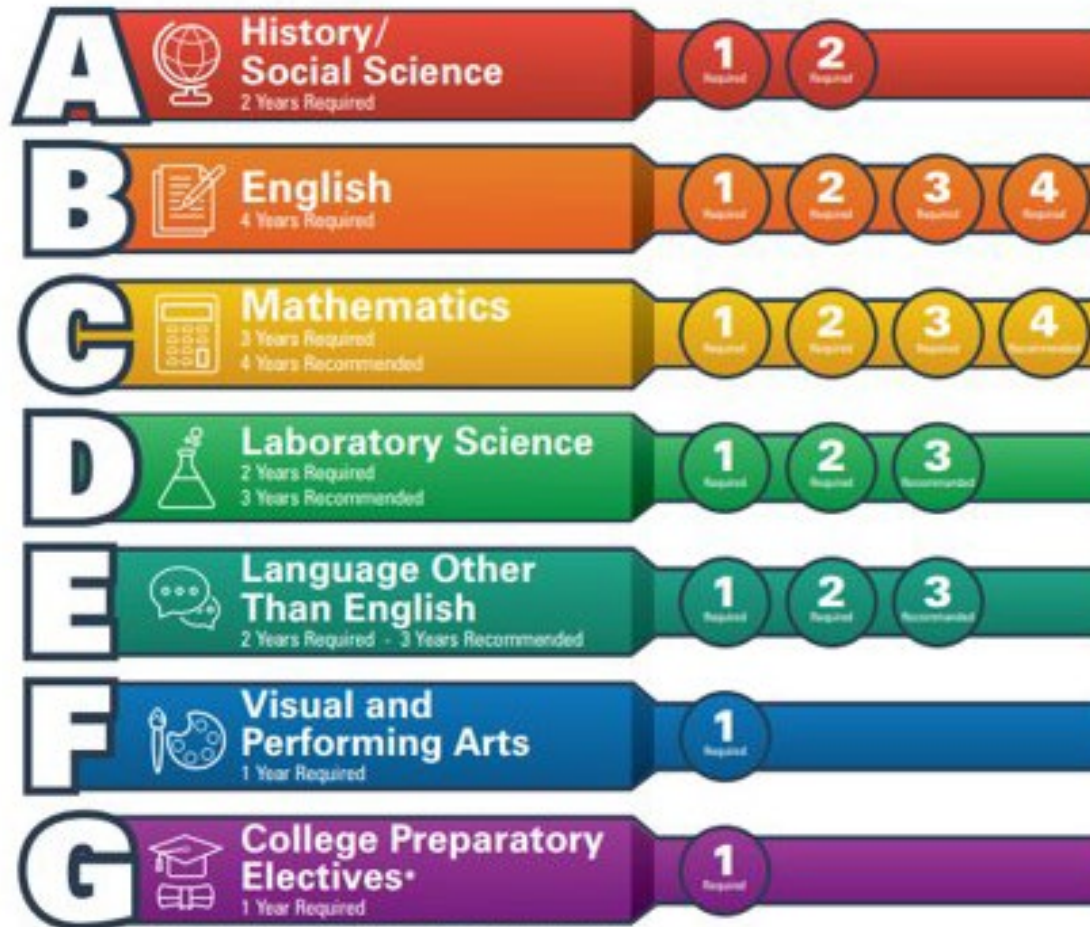

College Entrance Requirements A-G



*Any courses taken in excess of the minimum required in any subject area may count toward the fulfillment of the College Preparatory Elective requirement.



CSU Admissions Requirements

- **23 Campuses**
- **SAT or ACT requirement is no longer taken into consideration for admission.**
- **Apply online by: November 30, 2022**
(Application opens October 1)
- **Application Fee: \$70 or fee waiver based on family income, waiver imbedded in CSU apply application.**
- **No letters of recommendation and no personal statement will be accepted.**



UC Entrance Requirements

- 9 Campuses
- Applicants must earn a minimum 3.0 GPA in A-G classes
- **SAT and/or ACT will not be considered in the application process**
- Application Fee \$70 or fee waiver based on family income entered on application
- **Deadline November 30, 2022**
- Application requires completion of personal insight questions
- No letters of recommendation will be accepted

Private Universities/Colleges

- **80 Private Universities/Colleges in CA**
- **Vary in size, prestige, and cost**
- **Accept High School Graduates and Community College Transfers**
- **Typically requires letters of recommendation (counselor and teacher) & possibly SAT/ACT (check with individual school regarding requirements)**

College Essay & College Application Support with Myrl Johnson

Myrl Johnson is a retired English Teacher from Bullard. She provides services for students who need college essay assistance and application support. It is not generally necessary for junior college and CSUs.

Items to be covered:

- Write essays for college entrance
- Assess your personal college choices
- Receive tips for college acceptance
- Guidance through the Common App (private college) process
- Advice on Financial aid & scholarships
- Creation of a college resume
- Discussion about letters of recommendation and their roll in the college admission process

Documents For College Apps

Social Security number if applicable

Payment method- 4 year only, if not qualifying for fee waiver

Parent income for fee waiver

Letters of Recommendation

Only required for Private Colleges, Honors Programs and possibly scholarships

Please email your counselor at least 2 weeks before you need a letter of recommendation

If using common app or online recommendation, please enter counselor's/teacher's email correctly then check with them to make sure they received it.

Passwords & Deadlines

- Students need to keep track of passwords. They need a password for applications, portals financial aid, FSA ID, email and other accounts
- Students should check their email accounts and college portals regularly
- Don't miss deadlines. Colleges are very competitive and this may impact admissions status.
- Don't wait until the last minute.

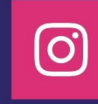
