<p>7</p> <p>Verification Forms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who have an incomplete FAFSA or Dream Act will be required to complete numerous forms, which can be very challenging for students and delay your financial aid award. It's critical to have an accurate FAFSA to prevent the overwhelming time you spend completing forms when it could have been prevented. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department of Education employs a verification selection process that sometimes makes it necessary for a student's information to be verified even if they completed an accurate FAFSA School will follow up with you to request forms/documentation to be completed (check your school student portal) When verification has been completed and processed, the financial aid office has the capabilities to submit the SAR electronically to FSA. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contact your counselor for assistance, to prevent delay in your financial aid award. Usually, after submitting completed forms to the financial aid office, it will take about 4-6 weeks to process. <p>8</p> <p>Accepting Your Award Letter</p> <p>Read it in detail</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> May and June, you will receive your award letters from all of the schools you applied to. It is critical that you understand that you can jeopardize your spot at the school you've been accepted waiting for a wait list from another school. If you wait too long you can potentially lose both. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have to either (Accept or Decline) the award and send it back to your prospective school. It is imperative that you carefully read your award letter and follow the instructions on the letter never assume you have been awarded financial aid without signing your award letter.
