- Parents/Guardians must communicate with their student regarding academic progress and not with the instructor or other college personnel;
- Students should enroll in college-level coursework;
- Students can enroll up to a maximum of 15 units per term, if enrolled in both CCAP and Non-CCAP, there is an eleven (11) unit limit;
- A high school pupil enrolled in a course offered through a CCAP partnership shall not be assessed any fee that is prohibited by Section 49011;
- No physical education courses may be taken or any course opportunities that do not assist in obtaining career technical education or preparation for transfer, improving high school graduation rates, or helping high school pupils achieve college and career readiness

CCAP enrollment is subject to the requirements of Section 76004 of the Education Code. By signing the CCAP Enrollment Form, the High School designee and College designee is certifying that they are in compliance with the requirements.
