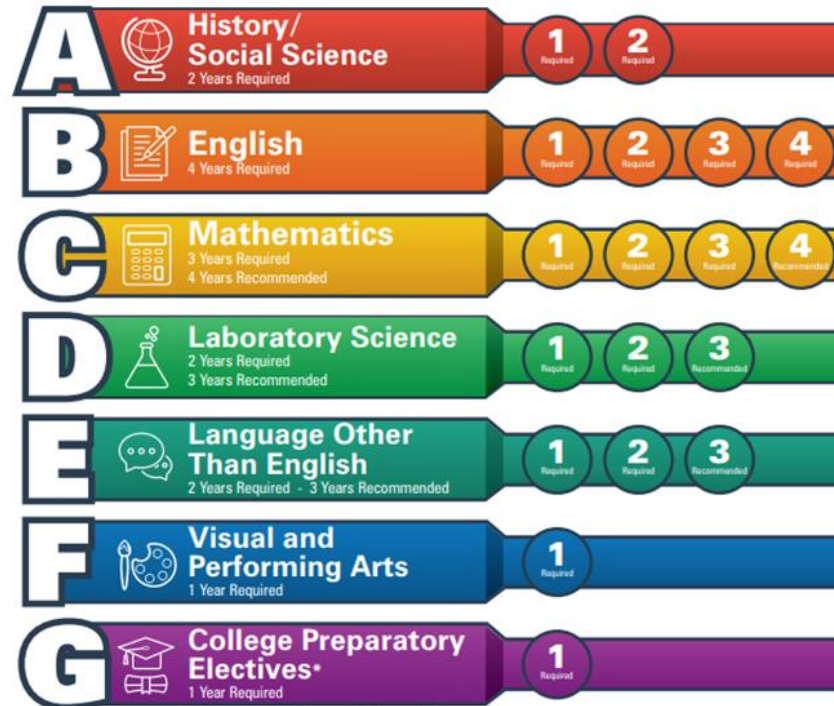

Students create accounts and can monitor and manage all applications in one place.

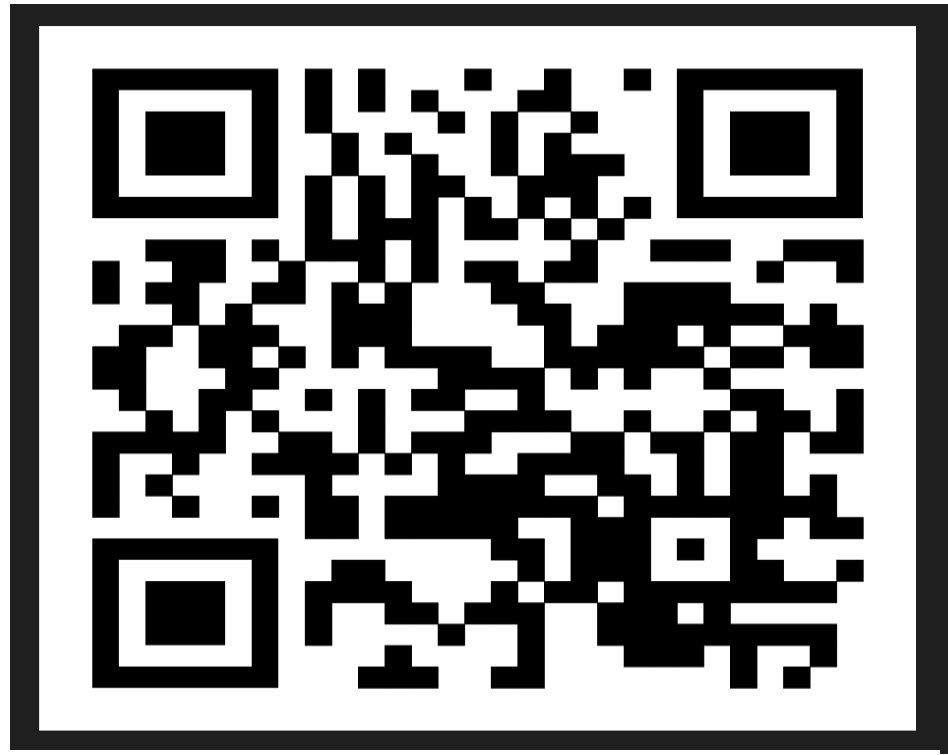
Student courses and grades are automatically populated on applications to help save time and reduce errors.

About The Program

Summary:

Bulldog Bound is Fresno State's guaranteed admissions program. It provides high school students from partnering school districts who meet the minimum California State University requirements a guaranteed spot at Fresno State after graduation.

The program ensures qualified students have a clear, tangible path to college. Fresno State will support students and their families with admission preparation as early as ninth grade.



Program Overview

Eligible Participants



9th Grade

- Students sign a guaranteed admissions agreement
- Students enroll and succeed in college preparatory courses (A-G requirements)
- Fresno State provides the following:
 - Fresno State ID
 - Fresno State email address
 - Library access for students
 - Parents/guardians sign up to join the parent community

10th Grade

- Students enroll and succeed in college preparatory courses (A-G requirements)
- Fresno State provides the following:
 - Campus tour
 - Career and academic major exploration
 - Summer experience
 - Parents/guardians are provided with financial literacy information

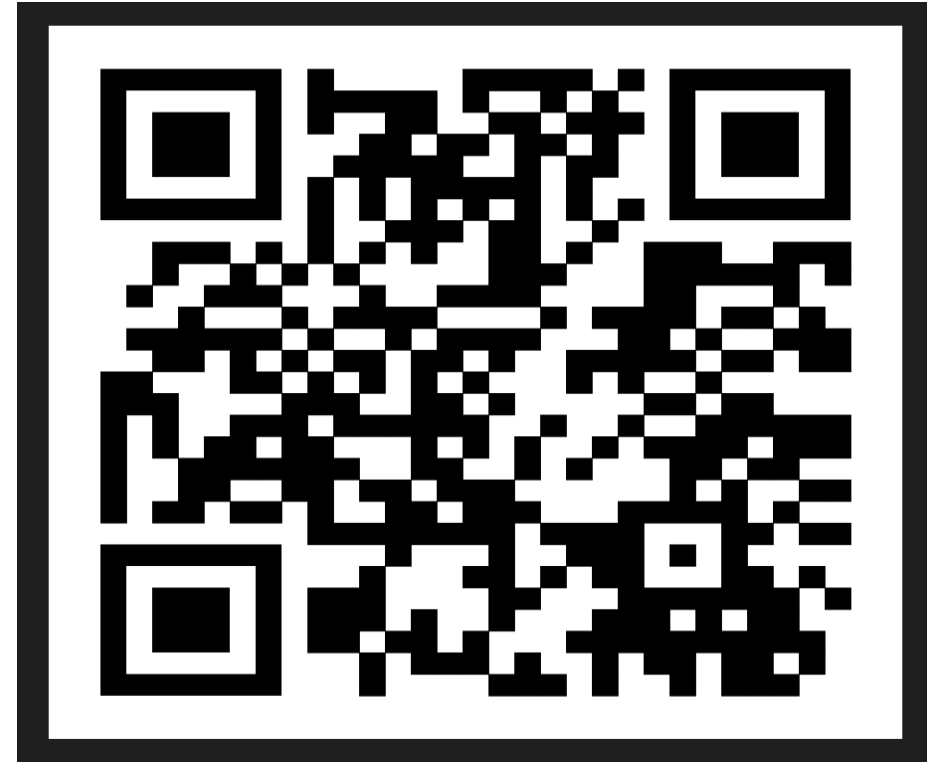
11th Grade

- Students enroll and succeed in college preparatory courses (A-G requirements)
- Students explore dual enrollment opportunities
- Fresno State provides the following:
 - Pre-admission qualification and pre-admission certificate
 - Summer experience
 - Cal State Apply workshops are available to parents/guardians

12th Grade

- Students enroll and succeed in college preparatory courses (A-G requirements)
- Fresno State provides the following:
 - On-the-spot admission
 - Early financial aid estimates
 - Scholarship opportunities
 - Parents/guardians and students attend senior admissions reception

- Public School Students, 9th–12th Grade
- California public school students eligible under the Local Control Funding Formula will be given CalKIDS accounts, if they were enrolled in 1st through 12th grades during the 2021-2022 academic year.
- Eligible public school students receive a:
 - \$500 automatic deposit in a CalKIDS account for eligible public school students
 - \$500 additional deposit in a CalKIDS account for eligible students identified as foster youth
 - \$500 additional deposit in a CalKIDS account for eligible students identified as homeless

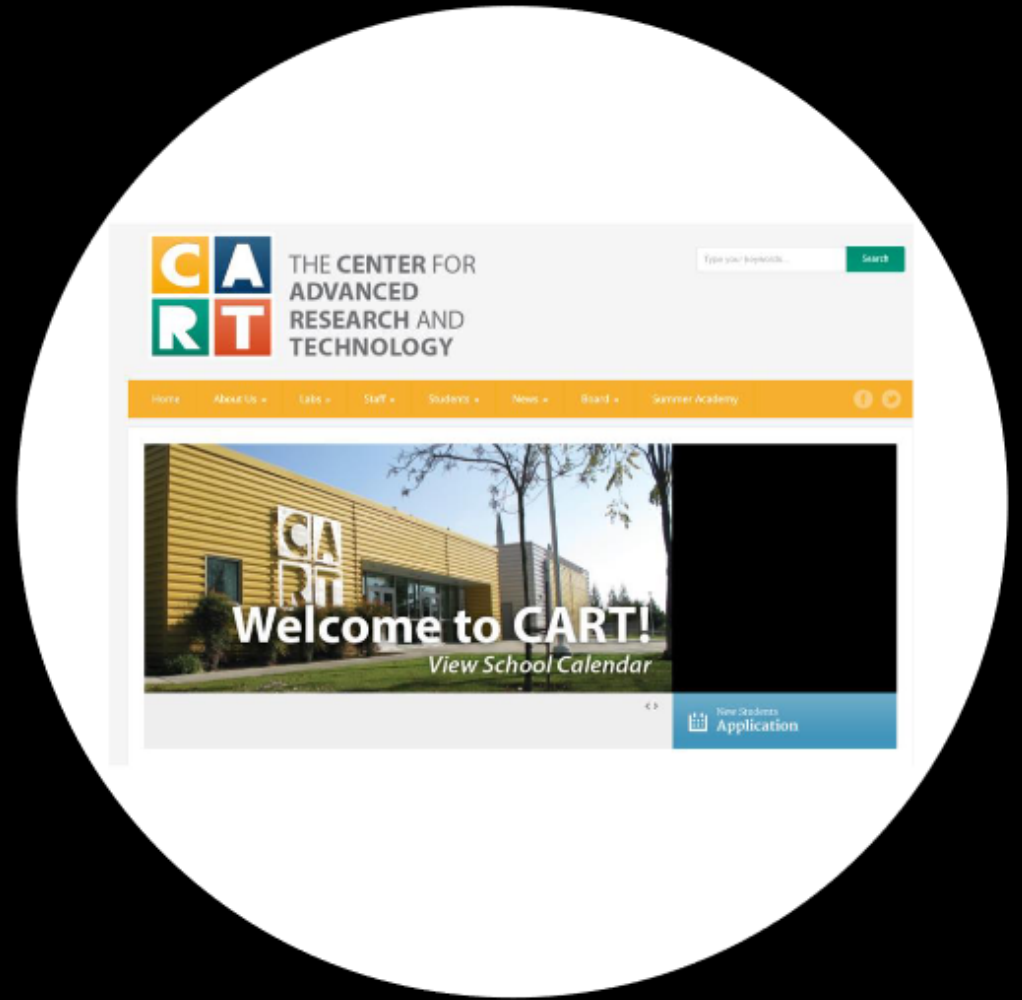
Many scholarships become available at the start of students' senior year. As juniors, this year is the perfect time to focus on their GPAs, as that is what many scholarships are based on.

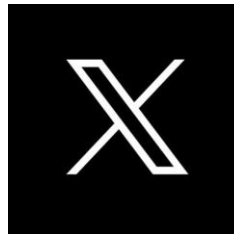
