

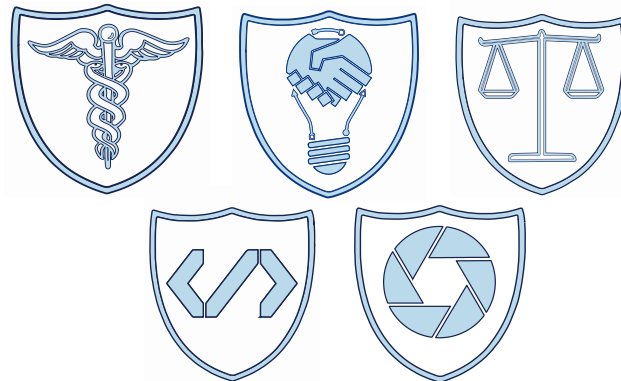

Impromptu- 2 minutes to prepare, 5 minute speech

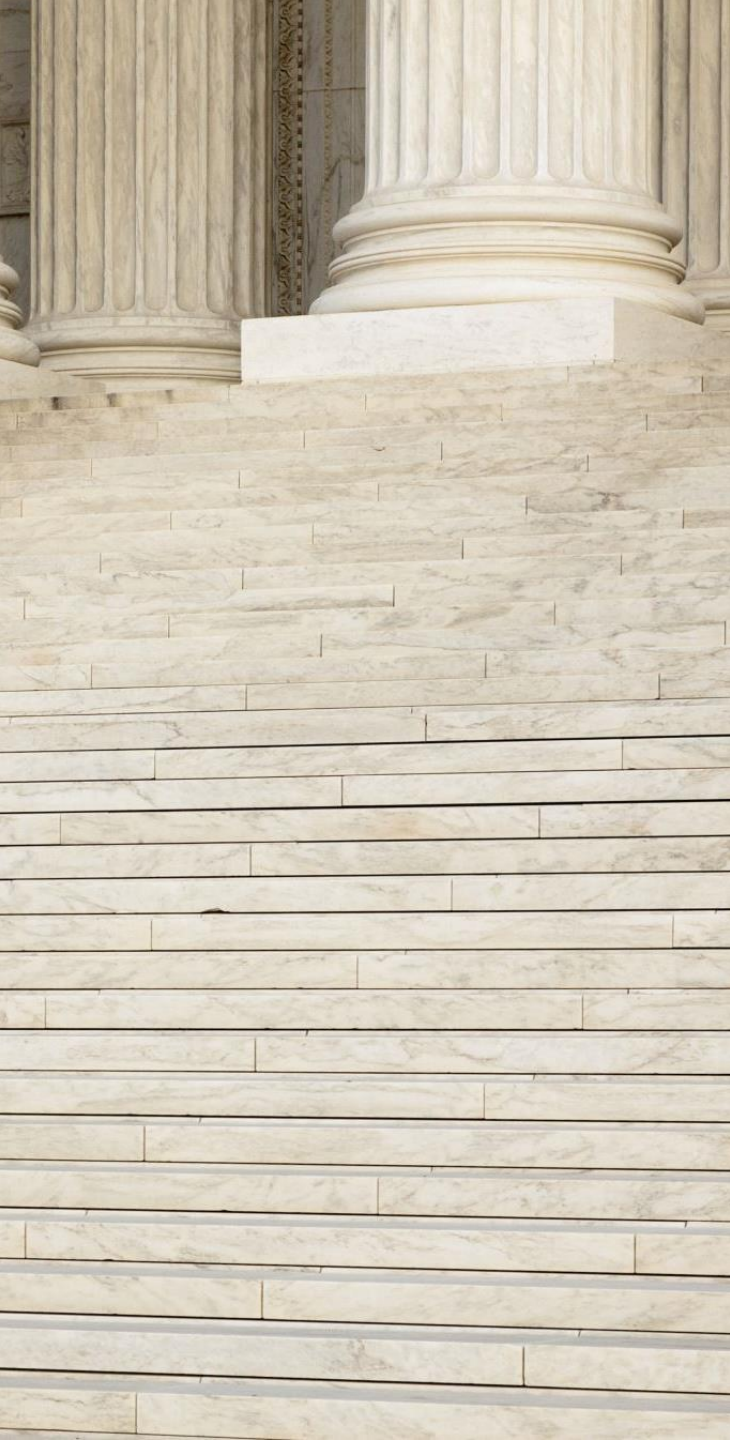
- Info- 10 min original informational speech with boards about any topic
- Duo- 8 min speech including two people
- Storytelling- 5 min telling of a children's story (only for Nationals)
- Expository- 5 min version of info w/ no boards, has to be informative

- Interp. (HI) (DI)- A ten-minute maximum speech
- Extemp- National and International, no preparation ahead of round, 7 minute speech
- OPP- Original Prose and Poetry, poems made by you
- OO- Original Oratory, speech about whatever you want
- Original Advocacy - 10 min original written speech on a modern problem in society

Debate:

Lincoln Douglas: 1 on 1 style debate

- You and an opponent take turns arguing a topic
- Philosophical debate prompts
- **Public Forum:** 2 on 2 style debate
- You and a partner take turns arguing another team on set topic



Mock Trial

- Start in September with a court case.
- Spend the first semester building a case for prosecution and defense.
- Compete in four competitions in January.
- Students will be working with an attorney throughout the whole process.
- The competition is at the courthouse and is done in front of an active judge.
- There is a role for every type of student.
