Horatio Alger CTE Scholarship

Criteria for Selection:

To apply for a scholarship:

- Applicants must meet the following criteria:
- Have completed high school (or equivalency) by July 1
- Plan to attend a not-for-profit community college or trade/vocational school
- Enroll in an associate's degree, certificate, or diploma program by September that will lead to employment may not be enrolled in pre-requisite courses
- Demonstrate financial need (applicants must show household income of \$100,000 or less)
- Be under the age of 35
- Be a United States citizen

Ray Jones Scholarship

The RAY JONES SCHOLARSHIP FUND, established in 2009 at Central Valley Community Foundation, provides financial assistance to selected California Indian students graduating from high school in the central valley. At least five scholarship awards each in the amount of \$2,500 may be awarded to selectected applicants seeking a postsecondary degree at an accredited two or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school, and at least one \$5,000 scholarship may be awarded to a selected applicant seeking a bachelor's degree at a four-year college or university. This scholarship serves California Indian students graduating from high school in Merced, Mariposa, Madera, Fresno, Kings and Tulare counties. Priority in the selection process is given to California Indian students graduating from Sierra High School in memory of Ray Jones, Class of 1965, and in honor of his Mono-Chukchansi heritage.

Hispanic Heritage Youth Scholarship
